The **InterContinental New York Barclay** hotel's newly constructed seven-room **Harold S. Vanderbilt Penthouse** suite is the crowning glory that sits atop the recently renovated historic building in Midtown. The 3,000-square-foot penthouse offers floor-to-ceiling breathtaking views of the iconic Chrysler Building and the New York City skyline. To entertain guests, the 1,300-square-foot rooftop provides an expansive outdoor living space boasting a wide outdoor dining area, a large decorative fountain and even an outdoor television.
